PRIORITIES

“Thou shalt have no other gods before Me”
(Exodus 20:3).

MONDAY

Scripture: Mark 12:28-31

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me love You more than anything or anyone else, and love others as I love myself.

TUESDAY

Scripture: Revelation 3:17-18

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me pursue those things that have eternal value, that honor You.

WEDNESDAY

Scripture: Genesis 35:1-4

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to remember that You alone are worthy of my worship, because You alone are sufficient in all my circumstances.

THURSDAY

Scripture: Matthew 6:19-21

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me invest myself, my very life, in those things that will last forever.

FRIDAY

Scripture: Matthew 6:33

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me order my priorities by putting those things You desire for me first.

SATURDAY

Scripture: Joshua 24:14-15

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me so model serving You first that my family will follow in serving You, too.

SUNDAY

Scripture: Luke 9:57-62

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to be so committed to putting You first that nothing can stand in the way.



WORSHIP

“Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image” (Exodus 3:4).

MONDAY

Scripture: 1 John 5:18-21

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to live in the truth that only You are the true God.

TUESDAY

Scripture: 1 Kings 18:19-39

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to remain steadfast in my worship of You no matter how great the challenges.

WEDNESDAY

Scripture: Habakkuk 2:18-20

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to identify and put aside anything that might become an object of worship.

THURSDAY

Scripture: Proverbs 9:10

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to live out the truth that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of true wisdom.

FRIDAY

Scripture: Romans 1:24-25

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to understand that living an acceptable life begins in true worship of You.

SATURDAY

Scripture: John 4:22-24

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me to worship You not just in outward expressions, but first, in spirit and in truth.

SUNDAY

Scripture: Revelation 22:7-9

Prayer Thought: Lord, help me, in response to who You are and all You have done, to worship You alone.
